## CLARIFICATIONS

1. RULE I. a. MATCH PROTOCOLS \& PROCEDURES: PRE-MATCH HUDDLING

After the CAA Sportsmanship Pledge (PLEDGE) is read aloud by one student-athlete from each team, players on Line-Up to start first set--and any player starting in a set--must proceed directly to their court positions.

Referee will confirm court positions prior to set play. Other teammates and coaches must proceed directly to their benches.

## CLARIFICATION

Teams are prohibited from huddling once the PLEDGE has been read. A coach's lastminute instruction/s, dissemination of pre-match strategy/ies, and/or team prayers, etc., must take place before the PLEDGE is read. Match play should commence as soon as possible after the PLEDGE has been read. The six starting players from each team in the/any set should proceed directly to their court positions without delay. Other teammates and coaches should proceed directly to their bench/es; players and assistant coaches must be seated during play. The head coach is permitted to stand [in the coaching zone] during play.

## 2. RULE VI. a. SUBSTITUTION: TEAM ROSTER AND PLAYER LINE-UP

 Paragraph 2Coach/es must complete \& submit a VOLLEYBALL TEAM ROSTER AND PLAYER LINE-UP to Referee before play begins using high school substitution Rules. A player line-up is how the referee/s keep track of a team's substitutions during a set.

## CLARIFICATION

DO NOT LIST STUDENT-ATHLETE'S LAST NAME on TEAM ROSTER AND PLAYER LINE-UP form. Please list player's first name only along with their jersey number. Teams with players having identical first names should use player's middle and/or last name initials to help distinguish between the two players.
