## CLARIFICATIONS

1. RULE II. UNIFORMS: a. Jewelry

Jewelry: players are allowed to wear small, secured stud or post jewelry above the chin.
"Friendship" fiber bracelets/anklets are still not allowed to be worn. A religious medal/fiber or/and a Medic A bracelet are not considered jewelry. Medic A bracelet may be visible; religious medal must be taped onto body and worn under uniform. Religious fiber bracelet must be taped over. Rule infractions may result in a team penalty.

## CLARIFICATION

REMINDER: Jewelry: players are allowed to wear small, secured stud or post jewelry above the chin. "Friendship" fiber bracelets/anklets are still not allowed to be worn.

## 2. RULE IV. a SERVING: NET HEIGHT \& ANTENNAS

A net serve (legally served ball hits the top of net in between the two antennas and crosses over into the opponent's court) is a live ball and should be played by the opposing team. A net serve crossing net legally that lands out-of-bounds results in side-out/point for opponent.

## CLARIFICATION

The net height is: 7 feet $41 / 8$ inches measured at the center of the net. Net height at the two ends must not exceed height by more than $3 / 4$ inches.

Two net antennas are required equipment for proper net set-up. Antennas should be fastened [as manufactured securely onto the net; each antenna should be placed immediately outside the left/right sidelines. AGAIN, place antennas on the outside edge of sideline.
3. VI. a. SUBSTITUTION: (Paragraph 2)

Coach/es must complete \& submit a VOLLEYBALL TEAM ROSTER AND PLAYER
LINE-UP to Referee before play begins using high school substitution Rules. A player line-up is how the referee/s keep track of a team's substitutions during a set.
