# **CHECKLIST**

**September 19, 2025** 

## - SITE SCHEDULE -

Visiting teams should arrive ½ hour prior to start time. If one (1) or two (2) matches are scheduled, all three (3) sets may be played. When 3 or more matches are scheduled at one site, all matches shall be 2 out of 3 sets. If teams split the first 2 sets, a 3rd set shall be played to determine the winning team. Sets 1 & 2 are won when a team reaches 25 points (cap at 27); Set 3 is won when a team reaches 15 points (cap at 17).

#### - REFEREE REMINDERS -

- \* Uniform: Black Pants, Athletic-soled Shoes; White CAA Logo Polo Shirt or a Plain White Short- or Long-Sleeve Polo Shirt
- \* Host Site Provides: Adult Site Supervisor; warm-up balls; a match ball; and a scorekeeper(s)
  Referee is the Official Scorekeeper for the match
- \* **Match ball** must be three-colored panels of blue/white/gray colors, *e.g.,* Baden Perfection 15-0; *or* an all-white, paneled, leather ball
- \* **5th/6th grade teams use the Volley-Lite volleyball**. (A regulation volleyball may be used for a set/entire match **only** if both coaches and the referee all agree.)
  - \* Prep League uses the Volley-Lite ball exclusively for play and the 'Jamboree!')

## - TEAM COMPOSITION -

Six (6) players comprise a playing team on the court. A team competes in a "league." Girls' teams with boy players may have up to two (2) boys playing on the court at any time. Boys are not allowed to play next to each other; girls are not allowed to play on a boys' team. <a href="Teams comprising five">Teams comprising five (5) eligible players may compete without any penalization</a>. When a team with 5 players sides-out and the vacant position rotates to the server position (right back), the team retains the serve/awarded point/match continues.

\* Re-Serve: permitted during any player's *turn-at-service* = occupying the serving position. *E.g.*, server tosses the ball but does not attempt to strike the ball. The ball may drop to floor, be caught, or touched, *etc.*, by server without penalty assessment. *Only* one re-serve *is permitted* during a player's *turn-at-service*. The referee blows whistle/hand signals for the re-serve.

The CAA does not use the libero position.



#### - COACH MENTOR -
